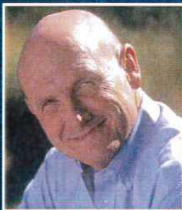

The basic principles that help an individual become more productive have not changed in 6,000 years.

Consider Covey's book 7 Habits of Highly Effective People and you find 1) be proactive and 2) first things first.

You cannot think any deeper than your vocabulary will allow you. Build a large working vocabulary by reading the scriptures and good books. Churchill had a working vocabulary of 25,000 words. A typical person has only 15,000 words and a teen 2,300.

Two words to get rid of in our speech – "like" and "so".

Make a list of words that describe Jesus Christ. Such as the following:

Character – the ability to carry out worthy decisions after the emotion of making that decision has past. It is doing what you said you were going to do.

Forgiving – requires remembering and deciding it doesn't matter anymore.

Elevator Speech as to what the Gospel is.

Adam and Eve had the Plan of Redemption, also known as the Plan of Happiness, the Plan of Salvation, and the Plan of Mercy. After they fell into mortality there were 5 steps back:

- 1) Justification – We must be totally pure to be in His presence.
We either commit no sin, pay for our sins ourselves, or allow the Savior to pay for us to obtain a remission of our sins.
- 2) Sanctification – Retain justification, refine and purify ourselves. Go to the temple and seal our families.
- 3) Sealing – Attain a level of faith like the brother of Jared so that the Holy Ghost will seal us to the Savior.
- 4) Death comes and then Resurrection
- 5) Glorification
